



The CMD's inaugural Regional Markets conference was held in December 2017 at the University of Melbourne and brought together a diverse group of experts and stakeholders with a view to creating better economic outcomes for regional Australians.

The conference focused on two key themes; the first explored how economists and policymakers consider market design in relation to reallocation of natural resources such as land and water and the second focused on the lack of competition among regional services (in particular, the regional health sector) and the challenges that contribute to that.
